School Update

Welcome Back! We hope you had a fantastic summer holiday and are well rested and ready to learn.

Attendance Matters

Your child's education is really important. Regular attendance at school increases your child's chance of getting good qualifications and a good job. Children need to attend school regularly to benefit from their education. Missing out on lessons leaves children vulnerable to falling behind. Children with poor attendance will achieve less in primary and secondary school.

The law states, that as a parent, you are responsible for:

- Ensuring your child(ren) receive full time education.
- Your child(ren)'s regular and punctual attendance at school.

This school year, each child will receive a sticker for every full week they are in school (to put on the attendance chart in the classroom). Every child who receives a sticker, will be entered into a draw to receive a prize. Five names will be drawn 'out of a hat' every Friday afternoon in assembly.

In conjunction with this, we will be keeping a very close eye on each child's attendance. Parents of children who are absent regularly will be invited into school to discuss their child's poor attendance with Mrs Hall, Deputy Head Teacher. Poor attendance may result in a fine.

Bolton Council have revised their 'Penalty Notice code of conduct' and parents who take their children out of school, unauthorised, for five or more school days will be fined. Fines start at £60 per child per parent and go up to £120 per child, per parent if not paid within 28 days.

We have attached a separate letter, from Bolton Council, with lots more information regarding school attendance.

Your child should attend school for 190 days of the year unless there are exceptional circumstances such as contagious illness, for example: chickenpox, impetigo, norovirus. If you are unsure whether your child is well enough for school we are always happy for them to attend and if they are unwell during the day we will contact you; unless, they have had vomiting or diarrhoea, in which case they must be kept at home for 48 hours after the last episode. School can give children prescribed medications such as paracetamol, ibuprofen and antibiotics if necessary (on completion of a medication form at the school office).

Dinner Money

If your child (years 3, 4, 5 and 6) has school dinners, payment is now due. The cost is £7.00 per week or £46.20 up until half term.
