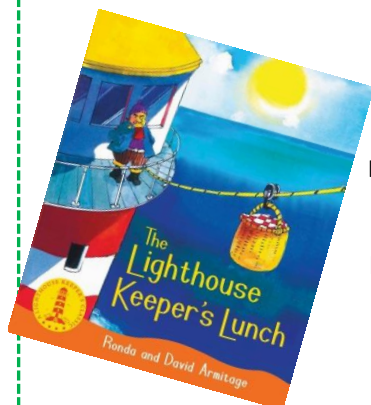

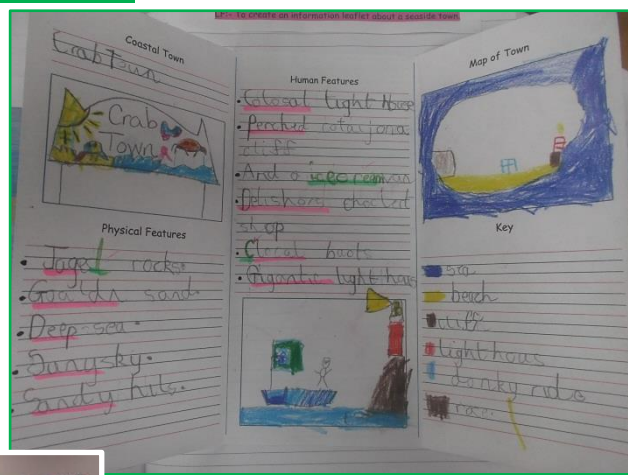


Class Focus – Koalas (1B)
