As well as joining in and motivating the pupils to try their hardest, Michael also gave children an inspirational talk. The children then had the opportunity to ask him questions.

PLEASE PARK CONSIDERATELY!

Please can parents consider others when driving and parking around school. School has received another complaint from a local resident. When parking please consider that people living around school also have children to get to school, jobs to go to and appointments to attend. Please do not block drives or cars in to spaces when dropping your children off. Also, emergencies can arise at any time therefore residents need to be able to get out and emergency services need to be able to get in.

We appreciate that it is difficult to park at peak times, but for the safety of everyone please do so sensibly. Even though there are no double yellow lines at the school entrance, it is still illegal to park with your wheels on the curb; it forces disabled people and prams on to the road. Cars parked on the curb also cause poor visibility for other children and adults. Council run 'spy cams' patrol regularly.
