- To increase pupil participation in competitive sport.
- To promote greater engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity (kick-starting healthy active lifestyles), particularly girls.
- To broaden the sporting opportunities and experiences available to pupils.
- To develop a love of sport and physical activity.
